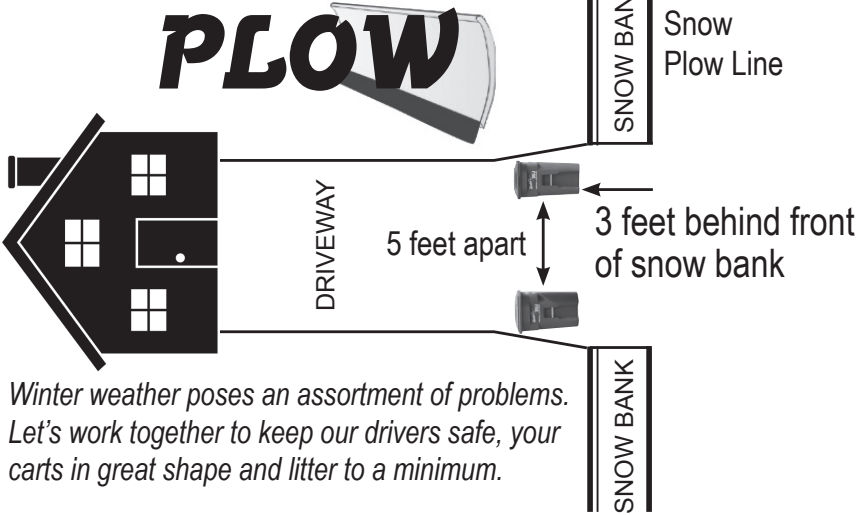


WINTER CART PLACEMENT

**Back it up
3' feet
for the
PLOW**



Winter weather poses an assortment of problems. Let's work together to keep our drivers safe, your carts in great shape and litter to a minimum.

Help by putting your carts in the correct winter position.

- Keep your carts 3 feet behind the SNOW PLOW LINE.
- Place the wheels and handles facing your home.
- Place carts on each side of driveway or at least 5 feet apart from each other and away from obstructions.
- Do not place carts on top of snowbank.
- Do not place carts in road.
- When necessary shovel a path wide enough for the carts to be placed 5 feet apart and 3 feet back.

We collect both trash and recycling using automated equipment. If your

carts are too close together or handles and wheels are facing the driving lane, our equipment cannot dump them. Our driver will need to exit the truck and reposition the cart, putting them at increased risk from other vehicles, slips, trips and falls.
