

HOLIDAY RECYCLING

Some things **DO NOT** belong in your recycling cart.
Some things **DO NOT** belong in your trash cart either.

RECYCLE IN CART

- Plain wrapping paper and plain paper gift bags.
- Corrugated cardboard and gift boxes.
- Paper greeting cards without glitter.
- Shiny inserts, catalogs, junk mail.

TRASH

- Tinsel, ornaments, plastic and evergreen wreaths or garland.
- Ribbon and bows.
- Gift wrap: shiny, foil, glitter or mylar.
- Gift bags: plastic, foil, mylar, glitter, plastic or string handles.
- Tissue paper.
- Tableware – Paper, Plastic, Foam: plates, cups, cutlery, napkins & tablecloths.
- Cookware: Foil and foil pans.
- Alkaline Batteries.

RECYCLE ELSEWHERE

- **Live Christmas Trees:** see below.
- **Christmas Lights and Cords:** see below.
- **Rechargeable Batteries:** WLSSD, Home Depot, Batteries Plus, Staples or check with other stores.
- **Single Use Plastic Bags:** Super One, Target, Kohl's or check with other stores.
