

# YARD WASTE COLLECTION

On-Call Cart Service  
May – October

When it's time to clean up your yard or garden, we're here to help with our on-call service.

What you need to do:

1. Sign up for Yard Waste Service
2. Call for pickup, before 12 noon, the day prior to your trash service or sign up for weekly pickup.

## What goes into the Yard Waste Cart?

We accept grass clippings, leaves, garden and house plants, loose straw and hay, vegetable and fruit plants, and flowers.

## If you have more than fits in the cart:

**May & October:** Over 4, up to 12, paper compostable bags outside cart will be charged \$3/bag

**June – September:** All paper compostable bags outside of cart will be charged \$3/bag



Bags that are acceptable.



## Unacceptable items can go to WLSSD's Yard Waste Compost Site:

- Brush and Branches larger than 1/4" diameter
- Stumps and Root Balls less than 4' tall and 4' in diameter
- Dirt/Sand and Sod in small amounts

**Materials Recovery Center:**

- Rocks/Gravel in small amounts
